Dear Chief Anderson:

I hope this letter finds you well.

On behalf of our member, CMSgt Hirner who is proceeding under the laws of the AF-BCMR pro se with our assistance, we are enclosing herein for filing with the Board, the following documents in support of his Application to remove material error and injustice from his military records under the provisions of Title 10 U.S.C. § 1034(f) et seq., ("The Military Whistleblower Protection Act") and Title 10 U.S.C. § 1552 et seq:

1. Application for Correction of Military Records dated August 11, 2008;
2. Memorandum of Law ("MOL") in Support of Application for Correction of Military Records with supporting documentary evidence; and
3. CMSgt Hirner/VERPA Privacy Act (PA) Waiver and Authorization to Release Information to VERPA.

In addition to the above-cited documents, I will also be filing via separate cover a "VERPA Statement in Support of Requested Relief" that establishes our good faith attempts to remedy CMSgt Hirner's pro se Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) Disability Evaluation System (DES) problems at the AFRC-level of command to avoid this type of administrative filing.

Overall, CMSgt Hirner requests 1) that he be granted a personal hearing and the right to appear before the Board, 2) that he be appointed a military attorney under the provisions of 10 USC 1034 (3)(A)(i), with VERPA consult with said Judge Advocate, and 3), that he be granted the right under 10 USC 1034 (3)(B) the to depose and serve interrogatories upon relevant parties to fully prosecute his claims before the Board.


Finally, as I stated in my email to you of August 8, 2008, that states in part:

"as to whether there is a statute or regulation in place for the AFBCMR to review 'extraordinary' type cases wherein the member's immediate health and well-being and that of their dependants are at grave risk?"

--we firmly believe, that there are "special circumstances" in this case due to the Chief's wife and her mental and physical health and well-being that merit expedited consideration and adjudication of this case. Therefore, we are proceeding to file the above-cited documents with you via electronic mail so that we are confident the case is expeditiously docketed in the interest of justice.
